

Laugh & Learn (PreK)

On the Go

Sound awareness and auditory identification.

Children develop an understanding of vehicles and transportation vocabulary and also learn about signs and safety.

Home Sweet Home

Oral language usage, auditory attending, and discrimination.

Explore bath and bedtime routines and investigate animal and human homes.

Let's Play

Auditory sequencing and vocabulary. "Follow the Leader" and other playground games improve listening and speaking skills while strengthening movement and hand-eye coordination.

Outside my Window

Oral skills and sound awareness. Stretch imaginations by pretending to be in the rain, snow, and wind. Make instruments to imitate those sounds.

Carnival of Music

Gross/fine motor and oral language. Learn all about fairs and circuses. Play cooperative games to build social skills, like taking turns and listening to others.

Animals A-Dancing

Auditory sequencing, gross motor and speech sound production. Dance, hop, roll, and stomp with lovable animal friends while developing muscle coordination and spatial awareness.

Around the Farm

Auditory sequencing and vocabulary. Strengthen memory and sequence skills with stop-and-go games. Explore the farm theme by imitating farm sounds and doing fingerplays.

Out and About

Gross motor and vocabulary. Build on students natural attraction to the great outdoors. Take them on imaginary adventures to the mountains and the beach. Go on bike rides and picnics.

Splash!

Find patterns and vocabulary. Children seek and find patterns in threes with water friends. Move like penguins to a rhyme.

Move & Groove (PreK & K)

Jazz Kitchen

Listening skills and oral language. Children observe and accept others. Learn how to speak to friends and teachers and to listen attentively.

Sounds Abound

Auditory skills and expressive language. Respond to "up high"/"down low", and to verbs such as: hum, wave, sweep, etc. Echo words and sounds. Read numbers and count "how many"

Dance with Me

Auditory discrimination and word patterns.

Strengthen memory skills and develop students' abilities to follow directions by listening and dancing to tap, jazz, and ballet music. Practice Spanish vocabulary words.

Drums, Drums, Drums

Auditory and attending skills. Sharpen listening and attention skills while building a foundation for math, rhythm, and coordination with "call and response" activities and African music.

Feel the Music

Vocabulary development and auditory discrimination.

Explore the range of emotions expressed in classical music. Compare the sounds that various instruments make. Make predictions in the story.

Rhythms of the Land

Oral skills and sound awareness. Recognize and replicate steady beat and explore drums and other Native American instruments.

Giggles

Vocabulary development and sense of humor.

Enjoy wordplays, puns, and word silliness. Listen for vowel sounds. Explore the concepts of "fast" and "slow."

Join the Parade

Develop auditory discrimination skills and gross motor skills.

Have fun marching in time and developing steady beat. Clapping, dancing on tiptoes, and stop/freeze games all strengthen gross motor skills.

Jumping Beans

Self-control and auditory discrimination. Strengthen memory and sequence skills with activities involving the rhythms of Latin America.
